



Delany Place

Attractive Central Coast Accommodation Option For Religious, Parish Groups, and School Execs

Delany Place, a Patrician Brothers owned housing complex, is located at The Entrance on the Central Coast, just over an hour's drive north of Sydney. It consists of three recently constructed stand-alone houses two of which are available for use for most of the year outside of school holiday time. Each house is self-contained with modern and well-appointed kitchens, spacious bedrooms, and attractive living-room spaces. Internet access is available. One house has a large open space which can accommodate gatherings up to 20 people. It has a large screen TV which can be attached to a laptop. There are some rooms with ensuites.

Delany Place is within 10-12 minutes walking distance from the main shopping centre, the parish church, two service clubs, and is close to bus routes, including the Gosford bus route. It has an ocean and beaches a short walk away to the east and a lake and jetties a short work to the west. You can bring your own bed linen and towels or use those provided. There is off-road parking for six and more cars.

The setting and facilities lend themselves to options such as the following:

- Parish family groups
- Private retreats or R&R by religious groups or individuals
- Distraction-free work location for school execs, parish committees, or individual Religious (not available for use by school students)
- Day conference

Costs: The fee is \$170 per house per night. One-night stays require negotiation. Day conference: \$100.
